EXPERIENCE Mr. Norris has been a relief printmaker focusing on woodblocks since 2010, after

many years as an amateur and exhibiting photographer. His prints and photographs have been influenced by 50+ years of professional practice in architecture, urban design, and waterfront planning, where he gained recognition as an expert in the fields of ferry systems and waterfront plans. His prints reflect a lifetime of worldwide travels and observation of the shoreline, its flora and fauna, the natural and built

marine environment, and emerging climate transformations.

As a long time resident of Cambridge, Mr. Norris spends as much time as possible exploring and recording the nooks and crannies of the New England coast from Maine to Cape Cod, by land and by sea. He is currently cutting blocks and pulling prints at Shepherd Maudsleigh Studios in Newton. Mr. Norris has also recently
